About the Program

What is the Qudorat Program?

The Qudorat Program is an official registration program launched by the Abu Dhabi Public Health Centre to organize and develop the competencies of professional entities and individuals practicing occupational health and safety in the Emirate of Abu Dhabi.

What is the objective of the Qudorat Program?

The objective of the OSH Practitioner and Service Provider Registration Program under Qudorat is to ensure that those who are practicing Occupational Safety and Health, either individually or within an office providing professional services, are able to demonstrate competency within their chosen field to a benchmarked level.

What is required to register in the Qudorat program?

To register in the Qudorat Program, applicants must undergo a formal and impartial process to assess their qualifications, which includes a review of education, practical experience, level of resources, training, or a combination of these elements. This process aims to ensure that those registered to provide occupational safety and health services have met a benchmarked level of competency. Applicants are required to be highly qualified and competent to ensure the delivery of high-quality and reliable occupational safety and health services, and to comply with the requirements of the Abu Dhabi Occupational Safety and Health System Framework (ADOSH-SF).



Who is required to register?

All individuals or professional entities who wish to engage in occupational safety and health activities whether by practicing or providing OSH services within the Emirate of Abu Dhabi are required to register.

Is it mandatory to register for the Qudorat Program?

Yes. The registration is mandatory only within the Emirate of Abu Dhabi for providing OSH Services.

Categories & Requirements

Who can apply for the Occupational Safety and Health Practitioner registration service?

Any individual can apply through TAMM to register as an Occupational Safety and Health practitioner, provided they meet the required qualifications and experience.

What categories are included in the Qudorat Program?

During the initial launch phase, the Qudorat program will cover the following categories:

- OSH General Practitioner
- OSH Senior Practitioner
- OSH Auditor

Additional categories may be introduced in later phases as part of the program's ongoing development.

What are the requirements for an OSH General Practitioner?

Occupational safety and health qualification certificate equivalent to Emirates qualification framework Level 4 or membership to a professional accreditation body at a specified level.

What are the requirements for an OSH Senior Practitioner?

Occupational safety and health qualification certificate equivalent to Emirates qualification framework Level 7 or membership to a professional accreditation body at a specified level.

Minimum 3 years experience delivering Occupational Safety and Health within an entity.

What are the requirements for an OSH Auditor?

Current registration at the grade of lead auditor with an international professional accreditation body e.g. IRCA.

Is the service limited to healthcare professionals only?

No. The service is not limited to healthcare professionals; any individual with relevant qualifications and experience in occupational safety and health may apply.

Does my certificate meet the program requirements?

Applicants are advised to refer to the framework of the National Qualifications Authority (NQA). The NQA provides official guidance, including qualification equivalency frameworks aligned with UK and Scottish education standards, which can support applicants in determining the suitability of their certifications against the program requirements.

If I hold a higher academic qualification, can I apply as a Senior Practitioner?

Holding a higher academic qualification does not automatically qualify an applicant for a Senior Practitioner role. While applicants with advanced qualifications may apply for senior-level registration, they are required to successfully complete the relevant level assessment as part of the program requirements. It should be noted that the classification of "Senior Practitioner" is determined based on the applicant's current professional role and responsibilities, rather than academic qualifications alone.



Registration

How can I register?

Applications will be submitted through the TAMM platform, completing the online application by following the given instructions and uploading the required documents. Then to submit the application for evaluation.

How much is the registration fee?

The approved registration fee is AED 540.

Can the Entity or Practitioner register for more than one type at the same time?

Yes, subject to satisfying the respective registration requirements as prescribed in ADOSH-SF – Mechanism 7 – Occupational Safety and Health Practitioner and Service Provider Registration.



Will applicants be required to pass an assessment or examination?

An examination process will be introduced at a later stage, this is to test the full understanding of the applicant with regards to OSH and the regulatory framework.

Can a fresh OSH graduate register in Qudorat?

Yes they can apply for registration as long as they meet the minimum requirements set within mechanism number 7.

Is it allowed for individuals (from outside the country) to register in Qudorat program?

No, they have to provide valid residence visa as per authorized government requirement.

How long does it take to complete the registration process and issuance of the certificate/card?

Initial Application review and verify details within 5 working days depending on the accuracy and completeness of information supplied.

What is the validity period for the Practitioner Registration Card?

The validity of the registration is one year from the date of issuance, or until a change takes place that will affect the grading. Upon expiry, please follow the renewal process requirements.

What is the procedure if the registration is not renewed?

If the card/registration has expired and not been renewed within the applicable time, the applicant will be required to make a new application.

Registration Details

What information must applicants provide about their work experience?

Applicants must provide details such as total years of experience, years of experience in the UAE, industry sector, job responsibilities related to occupational safety and health, and employer details.

Can applicants add more than one work experience in the application?

Yes. Applicants can add multiple work experiences to support their eligibility for the service.

What types of qualifications can be submitted when applying for the service?

Applicants can submit either an internationally recognized professional membership or a qualification or training certificate related to occupational safety and health.

Do international professional memberships require attestation from UAE authorities?

No. International certifications or memberships are typically verified through their issuing organization's website using the membership number and do not require attestation.

What documents must be uploaded when applying for the service?

Applicants must upload relevant qualifications or certifications, valid registrations/membership and experiences related to occupational safety and health.

What file formats are accepted when uploading documents?

The system accepts PDF, JPG, and PNG file formats.

Is there a maximum file size allowed for uploaded documents?

Yes. The maximum allowed file size is typically 15 MB.

Can the applicant edit personal information during the application?

No. Personal details such as address, email, and phone number are retrieved automatically from ICP records and cannot be edited within the service. They must first be updated through the official source (e.g., UAE PASS / ICP).

Will the application fee be refunded if the request is rejected?

No. If the application is rejected, the service fee is non-refundable.

What happens after submitting the application?

The application is sent to Abu Dhabi Public Health Centre backend system for review. Once approved, a certificate confirming registration as a practitioner or auditor is issued.
